WHAT THE GREENS WILL DO TO FIX THE ISSUES FACING LEWISHAM:

COST OF LIVING AND HOUSING

• The cost of housing is a major factor in the cost of living crisis. We will bring in rent control and other protections for renters.

• There has been a 23% increase in homelessness in Lewisham since 2019 We will prioritise building more social housing over those for private purchase.

• Lewisham residents have complained about cold and damp homes, mould, break-ins and lifts that don't work. We will put pressure on local and national government to fix these problems.

• We will also deliver a national housing insulation programme that offers people warm homes that are affordable to heat.

THE NHS

• We oppose the creeping privatisation of the NHS and the chronic underfunding of our health and social care systems over the last 14 years.

• To achieve the necessary funding levels for the NHS and social care, we will make the richest in society pay their fair share through a new wealth tax.

THE ENVIRONMENT

• Only Green MPs will hold a Labour government to account on the climate crisis and push them to be bolder and braver.

• There have been recent reports of illness in south-east London by people who believe this was due to the quality of the water. We will bring utilities such as water back into public hands to benefit ordinary people and we will clean up our seas and rivers.

PUBLIC TRANSPORT

• We will nationalise the railways and invest in local buses to make it cheaper and easier to use the greenest form of transport.

GAZA

• The Green Party was the first mainstream UK party to call for a ceasefire in Gaza since the very start of the war.
